

MAYOR'S MESSAGE

LACHLAN'S LINE

Many in the community will remember the media coverage given to a Building Work Rectification Order (BWRO) issued to the developers of an apartment complex at Lachlan's Line in January after serious defects were discovered in the building's structure.

While the Building Commission NSW was quick to issue assurances that the building was safe, some of the early sensationalist reporting caught many by surprise and caused stress to both residents and the wider community.

At the 26 March 2024 Council Meeting, City of Ryde resolved that a priority Councillor Information Bulletin will be issued in an instance where any further BWRO is issued that would require evacuation of residents and/or Council assets.

The details of any future BWROs will also be included on Council's web site, ensuring the City of Ryde community is kept fully informed about these important notifications.
