## MAYOR'S COMMUNITY MESSAGE

## **DENISTONE BOWLO**

You may recall that in September 2024, the City of Ryde went to the community seeking consultation about the future use of the Denistone Sports Club site, which was purchased by Council in June 2024.

Results from this process, which consisted of an online survey, written submissions and two drop-in sessions, identified food and drinks as the top activity the community wanted to see on the site, followed by bowling and social/event/club activities.

At the 25 March 2025 Ordinary Meeting, Council resolved to advertise Expressions of Interest (EOI), seeking submissions from suitable organisations for the management and operation of the club site and the top bowling green. A further report will be submitted to Council following the receipt of submissions through the EOI process. I am sure that this site will continue to serve the City of Ryde as a vital community asset, with residents able to enjoy both social and sporting activities at this scenic and well-located facility.

#### **EASTER CELEBRATION**



If you have young children, using reusable nappies is a great way to save money and reduce waste sent to landfill.


You will receive three FREE cloth nappies at the end of the session if you register in advance and attend the workshop.
