# MAYOR'S **COMMUNITY MESSAGE**

#### **OUR CIVIC CENTRE**

Today. I'd like to talk about how the City of Ryde envisions the long-awaited redevelopment of the Council-owned sites at 1 Devlin Street and 150 - 156 Blaxland Road.

1 Devlin Street site was the site of Ryde's former Civic Centre, which was demolished in September 2021 before a financially viable plan for its replacement had been put into place. There exists today only the infamous 'hole in the ground' which remains a blight on the former Council bodies that so badly mismanaged what was meant to be 'the new Heart of Ryde'. Council is preparing an Expression of Interest (EOI) campaign that will shortly go to market offering a longterm leasehold over the 1 Devlin Street site to deliver housing and optimal financial return to the City of Ryde, for reinvestment into

community facilities and infrastructure.

That reinvestment will focus on the adjoining 150 – 156 Blaxland Road

and Community Hub and Civic Centre will be constructed, including an element of affordable housing. Those plans will be open to extensive community consultation.

I'm looking forward with great anticipation to the market response to our EOI and to the developing plans that will finally give this City the Civic Centre it deserves.

#### **PUTNEY PARK**

Council is holding a drop-in session near the playground at Putney Park on Sunday 4 May from 10.00am -12.00pm where people can meet with our Project Team to discuss the draft concept design for the Putney Park regional playground upgrade. This exciting plan includes new custom play units, new swings including toddler seats, a new flying fox, new sand play items, new inclusive play items, additional seating and new accessible picnic shelters.

Along with the stunning Putney Beach, which was opened in January


2025, this upgrade will further enhance Putney Park as a go-to destination for both locals and visitors. You can view the draft concept design and provide feedback here:

Development Applications are available for inspection electronically and without charge at the Customer Service Centre, 1 Pope Street, Ryde (within the Top Ryde Shopping Centre) between 8.30am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday (2nd Thursday of each month – 10.00am to 5.00pm).
