At the commencement of this Council term, I made a clear commitment as Mayor to lead a Council that keeps rates low, improves financial sustainability, invests in local infrastructure, and enhances customer service and service delivery for our community. Council's 2025/26 Budget has been carefully framed to ensure that the average residential rate increase is limited to less than \$1.40 per week. Importantly, we have maintained all of Council's existing services, programs and projects, despite significant cost escalations across many fronts.
