## MAYOR'S **COMMUNITY MESSAGE**

## TG MILLNER RALLY

I want to thank the City of Ryde community for showing up in force at the Save Our Open Space rally on Saturday 19 July.

Together, we were able to send a powerful message to the state and federal governments that the necessary residential uplift we're shouldering as part of our response to the housing crisis needs to be accompanied by essential infrastructure - including active open space.

There was some justified anger that our beloved TG Millner Fields are facing destruction for a housing development, potentially adding to what is becoming an acute shortage of active open space for our local sports teams to call home.

Both levels of government are architects of the significant residential uplift that will occur in the nearby Macquarie Park Innovation District

through the ambitious targets set by the National Housing Accord.

I hope they both step up to support the maintenance and provision of more active open space in our rapidly growing LGA – this is just as important to the wellbeing of local communities as building more townhouses and apartment towers.

## RYDE RESILIENCE

It's no secret that weather events are occurring with more frequency and severity, as evidenced by the storms that battered us in January, the east coast low that struck in May and the so-called 'bomb cyclone' of only a few weeks ago.

So, our Ryde Resilience session being held at Ryde Library on 30 July from 2.00 - 4.00pm is very timely. Council's Resource and Resilience officer will be providing emergency preparedness information and the opportunity to Get Prepared using the Red Cross Redi app to improve the

ability of our community to adapt and respond to emergency situations such as severe weather events.
