I'm excited to share an important update on the future of the former Ryde Civic Centre site at 1 Devlin Street.

Following a resolution passed at the 26 August Ordinary Council Meeting, Council will commence a Request for Tender (tender) to identify potential lessees for a longterm lease of the site in a move that will benefit the Ryde community for generations to come, while ensuring the land remains in public ownership. The tender process seeks proposals that deliver the best value-for-money outcome for Council and the community. The funds obtained at the outcome of this tender process will be reinvested into our community, including the delivery of new and improved cultural and community facilities.
