Eastwood traffic and parking study

Council is taking action to make the Eastwood area more accessible for all with a comprehensive Traffic, Parking, Cycling and Pedestrian Study.

The study will look at all the factors associated with traffic flow (vehicular, pedestrian and cycling), on-street and off-street parking needs as well as future land use. There have been multiple attempts by Victor Dominello MP to apply a band-aid parking fix to this situation. They have all failed and Council will not be making the same mistakes. The residents and commuters of Eastwood and the City of Ryde deserve much better.

The comprehensive study is likely to take four to six months to complete when procured

School safety

Road safety around schools is a priority for our community and Council is undertaking a program of traffic and parking investigations around all schools in the Ryde area.

This review takes a holistic view of the needs of local school communities when it comes to traffic flow, parking and pedestrian access to identify issues before they happen.

This proactive approach gives us an opportunity to plan and budget for solutions that will deliver better outcomes for each individual school and its local community.

The approach also takes into consideration other Council-initiated road and pedestrian safety infrastructure projects that will deliver practical solutions to an increasingly complex set of traffic issues

Reviews of the first four of 28 local schools identified in the prioritised schedule of investigations have begun and local parents and residents will be invited to contribute


Recognises outstanding service to the community over an extended period by a young person aged 16-25yrs.
