In addition, the Ryde Library will stage daily activities for children throughout the school holiday period including Story Time sessions, space themed creative classes and a coding club for youngsters.

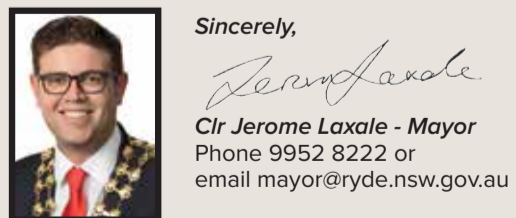
