Saying goodbye to single-use plastics

The City of Ryde showed it was fair dinkum about saving the environment when it voted unanimously to ban plastic straws and phase out all other single-use plastics from all City of Ryde operations and Council-sponsored events. Single-use plastics have become one of the biggest environmental challenges facing us as they pollute waterways and threaten the health and safety of native marine life.

Anyone who has undertaken a clean-up around Ryde's waterways would see the damage and debris single-use plastics cause and as a Council we need to do all we can to tackle this

Ryde continues fight against overdevelopment

The fight against overdevelopment unfortunately continues in the City of Ryde.

That is why Council has called on the State Government to abolish the controversial priority precincts in North Ryde, Macquarie Park and Epping.

Between July 2014 and May 2018, approximately 10,818 new dwellings have been approved in the Ryde local government area. Of those approved, 6,933 or 64% of the new dwellings were approved under the NSW Government planning programs, including those in two State Government Priority Precincts in Macquarie Park and North Ryde

If the State Government is really serious about overdevelopment, it will abolish its own priority precincts in North, Ryde, Macquarie Park and Epping. These three precincts alone will add more than 13,000 units along Epping Road.

In addition, the City of Ryde has also called for a permanent deferral of the medium density housing code and new planning proposals in Ryde until vital infrastructure projects are completed

When the temporary deferral was first announced by Planning Minister, the Hon. Anthony Roberts, he stated that it was to allow for 'infrastructure in certain areas to catch up'. Therefore it is only fair that the appropriate infrastructure is built before the new code and new planning proposals are allowed to be implemented.
