During this pause, the developer has advised that they will undertake further community consultation about the future of Macquarie Ice Rink. I would encourage everyone to participate.

Many have asked why the developer would demolish such a successful attraction at Macquarie Centre. Well the decision stems back to a forced State Government rezoning of the site to allow for a 37-storey residential development.

In 2014, the NSW Government rezoned this site as part of its Priority Precinct. The City of Ryde opposed this rezoning, yet the NSW Government proceeded.
