Congratulations to the North Ryde RSL Cricket Club after they reclaimed the 'Ashes' against old foe Norton Oakes Cricket Club at ELS Hall Park.

The rivalry between the two clubs dates back to 1985 after Norton Oakes travelled from the UK to play North Ryde. Since the 1985 tour, North Ryde made a return visit in 1986 with subsequent tours taking place in 1991, 1996, 2001, 2006, 2011 and 2016.

Transforming Eastwood

There is certainly a lot going on in Eastwood at the moment. Just last week a development application was lodged by the City of Ryde for the new Rowe Street East shopper car park.

The new multi-storey shopper car park will be located at 53-71 Rowe Street, have a minimum of 150 spaces and – in a first for a City of Ryde-owned facility – will feature charging stations for electric

At the same time, consultation is taking place on a proposal to relocate the Glen Street car park to the nearby Shaftsbury Road Precinct and then transforming the current site of the Glen Street car park into a public outdoor area.
