Council commits to build missing link in Ryde River Walk

Big news to come out of last week's Council meeting, with Councillors unanimously supporting a move to build the missing link of the Ryde River Walk between Bill Mitchell Park and Ross Street at Tennyson Point.

The Ryde River Walk is one of the jewels in our City's crown. However, the broken section at Tennyson Point forces people up a steep stairway and into local streets, making the walk difficult for some and depriving everyone of access to the most scenic sections of the river.

Fixing this missing link will make the Ryde River Walk accessible to everyone and open up more of the beautiful Parramatta foreshore to our entire community.

Enhancing Macquarie Park

As a result of recent conversations I have had with Macquarie Park stakeholders, it is clear that too many people are unaware about some of the great events, cafes, restaurants and open spaces in the area.

To overcome this, Council has committed to partner with local businesses, the live music industry, entertainment venues and other stakeholders to

develop strategies aimed at promoting the activities taking place at Macquarie Park. This will include the development and distribution of a promotional package that will provide local employees with an overview of the recreational and entertainment options available. Enhancing Macquarie Park's status as an entertainment and recreation destination will attract new businesses and enhance Macquarie Park's brand as the premier destination to work. It will also encourage employees to stay after work and attract people from outside the area.
