The picturesque Kissing Point Park in Putney will be the place to be this Sunday (19 May) with the Cork & Fork Festival taking place.

The City of Ryde's very own gourmet food and wine festival has an expanded site this year with some exciting new activities and musical entertainment that will keep the whole family entertained.

Adults will be able to indulge in premium wine from major wine growing regions of NSW as well as spirits, craft beer and great food. A 2019 branded Cork & Fork wine glass will need to be purchased on the day for \$5 to sample all of the wonderful wine, brewery and distillery suppliers on offer.

Meanwhile, for the kids there will be free workshops, face painting as well as unlimited rides available for \$20 and pony rides for \$5.

We do encourage all festival-goers to use public transport where possible as there is only very limited parking. The City of Ryde will have a shuttle bus operating between Meadowbank station, Putney shops and Kissing Point Park.

As no single-use plastic water bottles will be sold at the event, attendees are encouraged to bring their own water bottle which can be refilled throughout the day at Sydney Water stations located throughout the venue.
