Improving pedestrian safety

The City of Ryde has recently installed new speed check signs to encourage motorists to slow down in school zones and our neighbourhood streets.

The speed check signs inform motorists the speed they are travelling and notify them to slow down if they are over the speed limit. Each location for the speed check signs were determined by speed counts, resident concerns and other traffic data collected by Council.

In addition to the speed check signs, four mobile speed check trailers are undergoing upgrades before being placed back in targeted locations in the community and will be complimented by a new Slow Down In Our Street bin sticker campaign.

It is all part of Council's commitment to make pedestrian safety one of our priorities throughout all our neighbourhoods.
