Tender awarded for new Rowe Street East car park

I am delighted to report that the tender to construct the new shopper car park on Rowe Street East in Eastwood has been awarded to Belmadar Pty Ltd, with work slated to commence in October/November of this year.

The new multi-storey shopper car park will create jobs, fix chronic parking shortages and entice people back to Eastwood right when it is needed most.

Once completed, it will be able to accommodate 161 car spaces and include a small pop-up retail space. The final design also incorporates feedback that was received during Council's community consultation, including sustainable features such as electric vehicle chargers.

Work on the new car park is due to be completed in mid-2021.

Support for those affected by explosion in Beirut

Council has unanimously supported a motion to donate \$7,500 to the Lebanese Red Cross and \$2,500 to the Armenian National Committee of Australia's #BachigsForBeirut campaign to assist those affected by the devastating explosions that occurred in Beirut last month.
