

#### Ryde Wharf Market this Sunday

Be sure to pay a visit to Ryde Wharf Reserve along the picturesque Parramatta River this Sunday morning for the first-ever Ryde Wharf Market.

Taking place on the second Sunday of every month, the Ryde Wharf Market will showcase a variety of stalls offering homewares, fashion items, arts and craft as well as a range of food options, including vegan meals.

The fun kicks off from 8.00am and will run until 2.00pm. Marketgoers are encouraged to catch public transport where they can, as parking in the area is limited.

And a reminder that the Eastwood Night Markets return this Saturday at Eastwood Plaza between 4.00pm and 7.00pm. The revamped night markets will operate every Saturday and feature some new and exciting food vendors and stallholders.

## **Extension of Council rate rebate**

Council has unanimously resolved to extend the one-off \$400 council rate rebate for approved JobSeeker and JobKeeper applicants to March next year as part of our ongoing support for those within the community impacted by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. The extension means JobSeeker and JobKeeper applicants will now have until 31 March 2021 to apply for the rate rebate.

The one-off \$400 rate rebate was first endorsed by Council in April this year as part of a new COVID-19 Financial Hardship Policy with applications initially closing on 30 September 2020.

Since the policy came into effect, more than 320 applications for financial hardship have been registered, amounting to almost \$600,000 in deferred rates payments.

Council has also committed to providing further assistance to local businesses, with a focus on those in town centres.

Since the COVID-19 pandemic began, Council has waived \$112,000 in fees for businesses and \$76,000 in deferred lease payments for commercial tenants of Council.

Building on this ongoing support, Council will develop new small business initiatives with the input of each local Chamber of Commerce. These new initiatives will complement programs Council has already launched such as the Shop Local: Love Your Community campaign which encourages residents to shop locally through various promotions and offers.
