Council launches Ryde summer dining campaign

With COVID-19 restrictions set to ease in NSW this week, the City of Ryde has launched its summer dining campaign to support local restaurants and cafés.

As part of this new campaign, Council will waive outdoor dining and food inspection fees until March next year.

The waiving of these fees will provide a stimulus for restaurants and cafés to keep their doors open throughout the summer.

So be sure to visit the cafés and restaurants across the City of Ryde this summer. While out and about, you can also post a photo to social media using the hashtag #RydeSummerDining to show your support.

The summer dining campaign is the latest initiative Council has launched to support local businesses navigate their way through the current economic challenges. Since the COVID-19 pandemic began, Council has waived more than \$112,000 in fees for businesses.

Council rate rebate extended

In more good news, Council has unanimously resolved to extend the one-off \$400 council rate rebate for approved JobKeeper and JobSeeker applicants to 31 March 2021 as part of our ongoing support for those within the community impacted by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

The one-off \$400 rate rebate was first endorsed by Council in April this year as part of a new COVID-19 Financial Hardship Policy, with the initial round resulting in 220 rate rebates granted for a total of \$88,000. The extension of the council rate rebate will not only provide support for those still financially struggling due to the economic recession caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, but also aligns with the Federal Government's extension of the JobKeeper and JobSeeker programs.
