The New Heart of Ryde receives approval

In great news for the community, the Sydney North Planning Panel has approved the application to redevelop the Ryde Civic Centre site and proceed with The New Heart of Ryde project.

This project will deliver a four-fold increase in community facilities without the introduction of any residential development on the site.

The centrepiece of the project will be a new multi-purpose and cultural building dedicated to community use.

This building will feature the Edna Wilde Performance Hall – named after long-serving Ryde Eisteddfod Chairman and former City of Ryde Councillor and Mayor, Edna Wilde OAM – which will be able to seat up to 700 people.

The multi-purpose and cultural building will also include public activity rooms, meeting rooms, function space capable of hosting art exhibitions, amenities and food premises.

In addition, the site will feature an additional commercial building, a public plaza and 236 on-site basement car spaces.

Unlike other proposals for this site, The New Heart of Ryde has the backing of the community with 85% indicating they support the redevelopment.

And the Sydney North Planning Panel also voiced its support stating that The New Heart of Ryde “will make a significant positive contribution to the Ryde Town Centre”.
