The New Heart of Ryde update

I met with local residents last week to discuss the next exciting phase of the Ryde Civic Centre redevelopment.

This week marks the beginning of demolition works, which will continue over the following months.

Once these works are completed, construction can begin on the community and civic hub that will deliver a four-fold increase in community facilities.

This will include a new multi-purpose and cultural building featuring the new Edna Wilde Performance Hall, which will be able to seat up to 700 people, as well as public activity rooms, meeting rooms, function space capable of hosting art exhibitions, amenities and food premises.

An additional commercial building will also be built on the site which will house Council staff as well as external tenants. Other features include a centrally located public plaza, extensive landscaping works, direct and accessible pedestrian links, as well as 236 on-site basement car spaces.

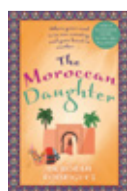
