It was great to join the Eastwood community to celebrate Lunar New Year and welcome in the Year of the Ox.

While COVID-19 restrictions prevented us from staging the traditional Lunar New Year event, Council were still able to stage a number of smaller activities for the whole community to enjoy.

During the Lunar New Year period, we also launched the Love Eastwood campaign in which the City of Ryde gave away \$40,000 in gift cards to be spent at participating Eastwood town centre businesses.

The response to the Love Eastwood campaign was terrific with more than 1,500 entries received. The lucky winners will receive their gift cards shortly, which will be valid until March 2022.

The New Heart of Ryde update

A stop work order placed on the Ryde Civic Centre redevelopment shows the extraordinary lengths that property developers will go to get their hands on the site so that they can build apartments there.

Demolition of the Ryde Civic Centre building was due to commence this week after plans to build a new community and civic hub on the site were unanimously approved by the State Government's Sydney North Planning Panel.

However, Heritage NSW issued a stop work notice late last Friday in response to criticisms about the redevelopment plans from developer lobbyist the Urban Taskforce.

This land grab by developers has the very real potential to derail a project

that has the support of 85 per cent of the community and rob us of our much-needed community facilities.

Given the massive importance of this project to the City of Ryde, I am willing to work with Heritage NSW night and day to find a quick resolution so that we can build this landmark piece of public infrastructure.
