Update on Ryde Civic Centre redevelopment

Last week, I had a productive meeting with Heritage NSW Chair Frank Howarth to discuss the stop work order that was placed on the Ryde Civic Centre redevelopment – seemingly at the behest of property developers.

During the meeting I presented reasons why Heritage NSW should lift the stop work order and allow Council to proceed with plans to replace the Ryde Civic Centre with a new, world class, community facility.

This included the fact that heritage matters were considered time and time again throughout the extensive planning process and were adequately dealt with through conditions of consent granted by the State Government's Sydney North Planning Panel.

Letters were also provided from the chairs of Council's Heritage, Arts, Economic and Renewable Energy Advisory Committees, supporting the redevelopment plans.

Given that the stop work order has the potential to cost ratepayers thousands of dollars a day, I sincerely hope that Heritage NSW quickly lift the stop work order so that we can proceed with delivering this amazing cultural and community hub for the City of Ryde.
