West Ryde Town Centre Masterplan

Residents have been crying out for an improved West Ryde Town Centre for a long time. It is clear that current planning controls will simply not deliver that.

So I am pleased to announce that consultation will soon begin on the draft West Ryde Town Centre Masterplan.

The masterplan aims to rejuvenate West Ryde Town Centre into a distinctive, vibrant and attractive centre without allowing overdevelopment.

As part of the consultation, Council will be asking for feedback on two potential options for the town centre. Both draft options have considered previous community feedback, infrastructure needs, and the need to minimise traffic congestion.

I would encourage everyone to review the draft masterplan options and provide feedback when consultation begins, which is due to occur later this month.
