100 years of women in local government

It was great to join past and present councillors to celebrate 100 years of women in local government by unveiling an honour board which recognises every woman who has served as a councillor at the City of Ryde.

A total of 17 women have served as councillors for the City of Ryde, with Edna Wilde OAM the only woman to have served as Mayor.

Mrs Wilde OAM was present at the unveiling as well as current serving councillors, Cllr Edwina Clifton and Cllr Penny Pedersen. Former deputy mayors Lyn Langtry and Gabrielle O'Donnell, and former councillors Nicole Campbell and Roslyn Lunsford were also present.

At a time when we need more female representation at local government level, this honour board also underscores how much work has to be done to make this happen. Of the 312 councillors who have served on the City of Ryde and Eastwood councils since 1870, only 17 of those were women. It is for this very reason that the City of Ryde recently joined the Australian Local Government Women's Association NSW to help run forums and training designed to encourage more women to run for Council.
