Electric vehicles

At last week's Council meeting, the City of Ryde has made a commitment to undertake a range of initiatives that will help residents make the transition from fuel-based cars to electric vehicles (EVs).

Already, Council has led the way in EV uptake by introducing EVs into its fleet and will complete the installation of our first two public chargers by the middle of the year, with another two online by the end of the year.

To build on this, Council has now pledged to go even further by incorporating EV chargers in existing and future urban renewal projects, while also undertaking a review of planning controls to support the mandatory installation of EV infrastructure as part of new housing developments.
