



### Get vaccinated

The latest COVID-19 outbreak in NSW once again highlights how important it is for every resident in the City of Ryde to get their COVID-19 vaccination as soon as they can.

You can check your eligibility for a COVID-19 vaccine and where you can receive it on the Federal Health Department website ([www.health.gov.au](http://www.health.gov.au)) and the NSW Health website ([www.health.nsw.gov.au](http://www.health.nsw.gov.au)).

### Changes to Council operations

Due to the NSW Government's stay-at-home orders for all of Greater Sydney, Council's Customer Service Centre, Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre and all five branches of City of Ryde libraries are closed.

In addition, all Council's community facilities are closed to the public. The City of Ryde Customer Service Call Centre will remain open while the stay-at-home orders are in effect. Members of the public can contact Council by calling 9952 8222 during business hours. Members of the public can also drop documentation intended for Council in the Ryde Library return chute, near the Pope Street entrance or mail them to City of Ryde, Locked Bag 2069, North Ryde NSW 1670.

The after-hours book return chutes will also be open at all library

branches during this period. Current loan periods on items have been extended to 11 July.

The Home Library Service is available for those aged over 60 years who are living independently, while library staff are working on reintroducing the Library2U home delivery service.

### Town centre upgrades

Work has begun on upgrades to two key town centres in the City of Ryde. The upgrades to Coxs Road neighbourhood centre in North Ryde and Ryedale Road in West Ryde will enhance both locations in line with community feedback.

Both streetscapes will be rebuilt as part of the revamp, with new landscaping, street furniture and other amenities to be installed. Overhead powerlines and old power poles will also be moved underground.

Once completed, these upgrades are going to look amazing and provide yet another much-needed boost to local businesses in both town centres.
