Council's COVID-19 support package

Ratepayers who have been adversely impacted by the ongoing Greater Sydney lockdown can now apply for a one-off \$400 rate rebate as part of the City of Ryde's COVID-19 support package.

To be eligible for the rate rebate, you need to have received a Commonwealth COVID-19 Disaster Payment, Small and Medium Business Support Payment or a Federal/State Grant for Micro Businesses.

In additional support, eligible pensioners will receive a \$50 one-off rate supplement and no interest will be charged on overdue rates until the end of the year.

More than 30 fees will be also waived and refunds issued to customers impacted by the current restrictions.

COVID-19 vaccinations

Council has resolved to write to Federal Health Minister Greg Hunt and NSW Health Minister Brad Hazzard urging them both to make all approved and suitable COVID-19 vaccines available to every age group, in particular those aged under 16 and over 60.

Ryde's vaccination rate is currently above the national average, but

there is still a great deal of concern in sections of the community about specific types of COVID-19 vaccine and who can access each one.

To address these concerns and help ensure everyone in the City of Ryde has the confidence to get the vaccine, we need to open up access to all suitable COVID-19 vaccines. High vaccination rates are the key to ending the lockdown that we are currently enduring, so it is essential that we make it easy for everyone to get vaccinated.

I would like to thank CIr Simon Zhou for bringing this matter to Council and his continued advocacy on the issue.
