Despite numerous setbacks including a developer-led stop work order and COVID-19 restrictions, I am pleased to say that Council is progressing well with the Ryde Civic Centre redevelopment.

Demolition of the old Ryde Civic Centre is now complete, with work soon to begin on building the new community and civic hub.

This hub will deliver our City a four-fold increase in community

facilities and activate this key part of Ryde, all while retaining public ownership of the site and without residential apartments.

Crucially, its construction will also generate jobs at such a critical time for our economy.

A number of significant items from the old Civic Centre such as signage, coat of arms and a mosaic floor design will be incorporated into the new development where possible.

More updates will be provided as this exciting project progresses.
