The City of Ryde continues to activate the Parramatta River foreshore area with work now complete on the Putney Park beach steps.

These beautiful sandstone steps open up this picturesque part of the river for the whole community to enjoy. continuing Council's efforts to make Parramatta River more accessible.

In addition, the completion of this important project means we are also one step (excuse the pun) closer to reaching our goal of making the Parramatta River swimmable by 2025, with Putney Park earmarked as one of three potential future swimming sites.

Please note that while the stairs and beach area is open to the public, swimming in Parramatta River is currently not allowed while testing is carried out.

Ryde joins campaign opposing **NSW Government cash grab**

The City of Ryde has joined with 22 other councils to call on the NSW Government to withdraw its planning contributions reform bill.

This is a bill, that if passed, would mean the cost of new infrastructure would be paid by ratepayers, instead of developers.

NSW councils currently tax property developers to fund local infrastructure for our growing communities. This money contributes to everything that makes our city liveable, from roads and drains to sports fields, playgrounds, pools and libraries.

However, the changes being proposed by the NSW Government will divert a large proportion of these developer contributions away from councils and into a Treasury-controlled fund, with no clear accountability or transparency of how it will be spent.

And to make things worse, to make up the shortfall, the Government want us to raise rates, which is completely unacceptable.
