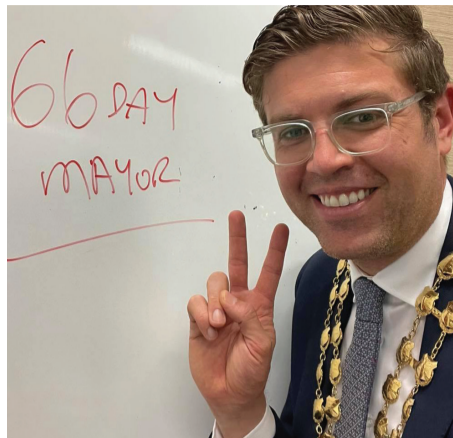

Mayoral election

I was honoured last week to be re-elected City of Ryde Mayor until the local government elections on 4 December.

While this term is only for 66 days, it is still a tremendous privilege to be given the opportunity to serve the community as Mayor.

The past two years have been some of the most challenging we will ever face due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but I am proud of the job that this Council has done to support everyone in the community up until this point and into the future.

I would like to thank my fellow councillors for their continued support and look forward to working with them as we navigate our way out of COVID-19 restrictions and continue to represent the community in the lead-up to the local government elections in December.

Bus interchange or fancy bus stop?

It was disappointing but hardly surprising that a promise from the Federal and State Government to build a new bus interchange for Macquarie Park has fallen well short once again.

Since the promise was made in 2017, Council has been lobbying extensively for a pedestrian-only public plaza to be built where Herring Road meets Waterloo Road, along with a new bus interchange.

Unfortunately this proposal has been ignored by Transport for NSW which wants to progress with plans that amount to nothing more than a fancy bus stop, with 'bus only' lanes installed and no public plaza.

The Transport for NSW proposal is completely inadequate for the growing needs of Macquarie Park and falls short of what was promised by both the Federal and State governments in 2017.

I call on Transport Minister Andrew Constance, Member for Ryde Victor Dominello and Member for Bennelong John Alexander to intervene to back Council's plan which would give Macquarie Park an improved town centre, a much-needed public plaza and upgrades to the existing bus interchange.
