#### **MATTER DETERMINED**

## LDA2023/0309

Address: 77 Pellisier Road, Putney (Putney Park)

**Proposal:** Installation of an in-river swim site in the Parramatta River, off the shore of Putney Park comprising an in-river enclosure constructed of a stainless-steel reinforced polyethylene net supported from a stainless-steel cable suspended from piles embedded into the seabed. The enclosure is accessed from a beach on the riverbank via existing sandstone stairs from the park.

#### PANEL CONSIDERATIONS AND DECISION

The Panel considered the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7, and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

## **DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION**
