MATTER DETERMINED

LDA2019/0445 – 96 West Parade, Denistone

Construction of a two storey child care centre for 96 children and 16 staff with basement parking for 18 vehicles. Proposed hours of operation are 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday.

There were no registered speakers for this meeting.

PANEL CONSIDERATIONS AND DECISION

The Panel considered the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7, and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION

The Panel determined to refuse the development application as described in Schedule 1, pursuant to Section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel determined to refuse the application for the following reasons:

- The proposal fails to achieve compliance with the floor space ratio development standard prescribed for the subject site, and no clause 4.6 written request has been provided.
- The proposal presents a range of non-compliances in relation to the CCPG and RDCP 2014 which result in an unacceptable built form and impacts to the streetscape and adjoining properties.
- A number of well-founded objections have been received following notification of the DA.

The Panel adopts the recommendation and reasons for refusal as outlined in the Assessment Officer's report subject to the deletion of 1a from the recommendation.

Not applicable - Refusal

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel considered written submissions made during public exhibition and heard from all those wishing to address the panel.

The Panel considers that concerns raised by the community have been adequately addressed in the assessment report. No new issues were raised during the public meeting.
