MATTER DETERMINED

LDA 2020/0295 – 1 Devlin Street, Ryde Demolition works and associated tree removal.

PANEL CONSIDERATIONS AND DECISION

The Panel considered the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7, and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION

The Panel determined to **approve** the development application as described in Schedule 1, pursuant to Section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel determined to **approve** the application for the following reasons:

- 1. The proposal is consistent with the objectives for B4 zoned land.
- 2. The proposal complies with the statutory provisions set out in the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.
- 3. Through the imposition of conditions, the proposal is considered to be low impact to adjoining properties and the surrounding environment.
- 4. The proposal is in the public interest.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the council assessment report with the addition of **point 7 to condition 23** to read as follows: All demolition workers and subcontractors must park their vehicles on the subject site at all times.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel notes that the amended application did not require notification under the Community Participation Plan.
