2 FORESHORE PROGRAM SEAWALL - MEADOWBANK

REPORT SUMMARY

This report details the identified issues, risks and solutions of the Seawall project at Meadowbank and recommends an increase to the scope and budget of the project to account for site conditions and for the impact of approvals from the Department of Primary Industry and the Roads and Maritime Services.

As a consequence of these impacts, and after a detailed review to mitigate against future risks regarding seawall projects, this report recommends proposed adjustments to listed projects within the Foreshore Program - Seawalls/Retaining Walls Refurbishment Renewal Program of the draft 2015-2019 Delivery Plan.

RECOMMENDATION:

- (a) That an amount of \$200,000 be added to the draft Operational Plan 2015 2016 Foreshore Program funded from the Section 94 Reserve prior to it being reported back to Council on 9 June 2015.
- (b) That the draft 2015 2019 Delivery Plan, Four Year Foreshore Program Seawalls / Retaining Walls Refurbishment Renewal Project, be amended as detailed in this report prior to it being reported back to Council on 9 June 2015.

Discussion

In the Delivery Plan 2014-18 under the Foreshore Program - Seawalls/Retaining Walls Refurbishment Renewal Program for 2014/15 Council allocated \$320,000 for the Reconstruction of a Seawall at Meadowbank. The estimate was based on the historical construction cost of the seawall at Memorial Park, just east of this location.

Once the investigations commenced a number of unforeseen issues were identified that has escalated the estimated construction cost as well as the time required. The main contributing issues and the impacts are outlined below.

There is an oil pipe line (known as Shell oil pipe line, currently owned by Viva Energy) that is close to the seawall within the zone of influence running behind the seawall. This is a major oil pipe line supplying the Shell Oil Refinery in Rosehill. Council has a statutory obligation to comply with the safety requirements of this pipe, and hence contacted Viva Energy for supervision during construction. In the past whilst in the ownership of Shell, the supervision was provided free of charge for the entire duration of construction, but now it has to be paid for by the hour, and added significant cost to the project.

Soft sediment conditions up to 7 metres deep to build the seawall on, was identified. That necessitated significant additional geotechnical investigation and footing design, including obtaining approvals from Viva Energy. This prolonged the design process, increasing costs and delaying project outcomes.

As a result, a larger footing was required. As the space between the seawall and the oil pipe line is limited, the alignment of the footing was shifted toward the bay, encroaching into the land owned by the Roads and Maritime Services (RMS). Council then approached the RMS seeking permission to lease their land. The approval process involved negotiations with the RMS and the Department of Primary Industries (DPI), extending the timeline further.

As a part of the RMS approval process Council undertook a Review of Environmental Factors (REF), which identified the reduction of the habitat for the saltmarsh and marine species and also the removal of some mangroves. Council then went back to the DPI, which is responsible for the management of marine species. The DPI required Council to provide an equivalent area of habitat in the vicinity of this project to compensate for the loss.

Council then investigated and mapped the vicinity of this project and identified the locations that can be dedicated in lieu for the above. Following site meetings with DPI and submissions with the appropriate plans the permit was granted, culminating in further delay and additional expenditure.

Subsequent to obtaining the permits, two trial sections were built to ascertain the acceptability of the design to meet the statutory obligations for the oil pipe line and that has further escalated the cost and time of this project.

Currently the estimated cost of this project is up to \$1,220,000 with the construction programmed to commence in July / August 2015. The current allocation of \$320,000 will be expended on purchasing the material before the end of financial year and a further \$900,000 will be required for 2015/16 to complete this project. The current budget is \$700,000 and will need to be increased by \$200,000.

Due to the size of this project, the delivery of the other subsequent seawall projects in the Foreshore Program will be impacted at other locations, commencing from 2015/16. Due to lessons learnt from the Seawall at Meadowbank it is proposed to defer the subsequent projects by a year and to split them into two stages, spanning over two years. Design, investigation and planning in the first year and the construction in the second, thus ensuring all risks are identified early and mitigated against, projects are designed accordingly, estimated accurately and sufficient time allocated for the construction. Please note priority is based on condition.

Financial Implications

Funding for the additional \$200,000 in the 2015-2016 Operational Plan is available from the Section 94 reserve. Please note the original program was as follows:

Projects Report

This report covers capital and non-capital projects in the Operational Plan 2014/15 delivered by the Project Development Unit (PDU), Public Works. Progress of projects in the Operational Plan 2014/15, approved carry over projects from 2013/14 and new projects approved during 2014/15 are shown in **ATTACHMENT 1**.

As at 30 April, the PDU is responsible for the delivery of 163 projects including:

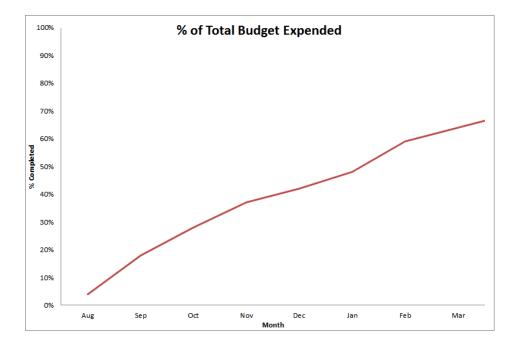
- 136 projects in the Operational Plan 2014/15
- 22 carry over projects from 2013/14
- 5 new projects approved during 2014/15

The PDU annual target (KPI) for completed operational plan and carryover projects is 85%. The current status is as follows:

Total budget (including carry-over projects)	\$26,828,049
Percentage of total approved budget expended*	68%

Excludes projects that are on-hold, awaiting approval by external authorities (e.g. RMS), Council resolution, awaiting finalisation of legal matters, and new projects adopted by Council from 1 July 2014.

The chart below plots monthly percentage of total approved budget expended.





A total of 78 out of 163 projects have been completed to date, with 10 projects completed in the month of April 2015. Severe wet weather in April delayed construction progress, but the forecast project completion percentage is still on track, with over 60 projects scheduled to be completed in the remaining 2 months of 2014/15, weather permitting.

The Capital Works Project Schedule 2014-2015 – April 2015 is provided in **ATTACHMENT 1** and the job card of a completed project is provided in **ATTACHMENT 2**.
