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RTC COMMENTS:

Mr Vince Cusumano, a resident of Taylor Avenue advised the Committee that he did not consider that Taylor Avenue was a suitable location for a pedestrian refuge and he considered that bus stops on Victoria Road were within the 400m distance as required under the associated SEPP for Seniors Living. He acknowledged that access to/from his property for his car and boat trailer could still be undertaken even with the installation of the proposed pedestrian refuge.

Mr Carthy representing Land and Housing Corporation (LAHC NSW) gave a brief history behind the proposed seniors development proposed at 141-143 Cobham Avenue; he then indicated that his architect and traffic engineer would discuss the project from a traffic and road safety perspective.

Mr Bebek, architect for LAHC NSW, advised the Committee on the 400m rule concerning access to public transport and need for safe access to this mode of transport. He indicated that Taylor Avenue would not meet the required warrants for a pedestrian crossing to be installed, hence the reason why a pedestrian refuge was proposed. There was some disagreement regarding the distance to the nearest bus stop, Mr Bebek tabled the accessibility report which had been prepared by a wheelchair bound consultant who determined that only Taylor Avenue fell within the 400m bus stop boundary.

Mr Sannikov, traffic engineer for LAHC NSW advised the Committee that some minor modification to the pedestrian refuge was required to facilitate access/egress for a car and boat to Nos 3 & 5 Taylor Avenue. This modification would not detract from the integrity of the proposed pedestrian refuge. He advised that the proposed pedestrian refuge would visually reduce the width of the intersection and thus would require all vehicles to reduce their speed as they pass through the intersection.

The Chairman requested that LAHC NSW verify its accessibility report regarding the 400m distance to public transport.

RTC RESOLUTION

The Ryde Traffic Committee recommends that the pedestrian refuge and associated signage on Taylor Avenue at Cobham Avenue as shown in Figure G7 be approved in principle, subject to the accessibility assessment (distance wise) been verified with reference to the bus stops on Victoria Road in close proximity to Wharf Road.
