Terms of Reference

Mission statement

The Ryde Hunters Hill Youth Interagency was established for the benefit and development of youth services and young people in the City of Ryde and Hunters Hill Council areas.

Objectives

- To create connectivity, communication, information sharing and resource sharing across and within the two Local Government Areas
- To further the development of youth specific services, organisations and activities
- To further the concerns and issues of young people
- To further the issues and concerns of youth workers
- To work together via assisting and further developing partnerships, projects, programs and activities.

Aims/ Goals/ Purpose and Values

- To have an understanding of the needs and concerns of young people and youth workers
- To create more accessible youth services in Ryde and Hunters Hill

Membership

Membership to the RHHYI is open to any services, organisation and agencies that work for the benefit of young people in the Ryde and Hunters Hill local government area.

Procedures and Administration

The City of Ryde Community Services team is responsible for the administration and chairing of the Youth Interagency.

Agendas will be circulated one week prior to the meeting date.

Minutes will be circulated no later than two weeks following a meeting.

Meetings

Meetings will be held monthly on the first Tuesday of the month from 10am to 11:30am online via MS Teams. Extra meetings can be held in the case of events, training or special projects of the group.

Review

A review of the Terms of Reference and the group will occur, two years following the endorsement of the Terms of Reference and the commencement of the Ryde Hunters Hill Youth Interagency.
