
**MM31/22 STRONGER TOGETHER GRANTS PROGRAM - Mayor,
Councillor Jordan Lane**

I have been made aware of a NSW Government grant initiative designed to invest in local communities and support organisations that make Council's multicultural calendar more vibrant and accessible.

Grants are now available through Multicultural NSW's *Stronger Together Grants Program* to help local organisations deliver these multicultural events.

Eligible applicants can apply for funding between \$5,000 and \$15,000 for events and festivals.

Previously, this program has supported community Harmony Day events, interfaith and intercultural conferences and social inclusion sports days.

Council will need to partner with a community organisation to apply for the grant as Councils are excluded from applying in their own right.

I recommend that staff approach suitable community organisation/s to enable an application to be submitted for this grant funding.

Applications must be submitted by 28 October 2022.


RECOMMENDATION:
