

## MM23/12 PRINCES STREET - PARKING - The Mayor, Councillor Ivan Petch

I have received many complaints from residents of Calvary Nursing Home (Dalton Gardens) relating to the dangerous situation posed in Princes Street heading in the direction of Morrison Road.

The problem is caused because vehicles park on both sides of the road which limits access to through traffic.

There is literally nowhere for two vehicles to pass because of the manner in which the vehicles park.

I have raised this matter with the Group Manger – Public Works who referred the issue to the Traffic Committee.

The Traffic Committee has recommended the installation of no stopping signs along the side frontage of the Royal Ryde Rehabilitation Centre for a distance of 150m from the Morrison Road intersection.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council approve the installation of 150m of "no stopping" signs along the side frontage (Princes Street) of the Royal Ryde Rehabilitation Centre, commencing at the Morrison Road intersection to improve accessibility and safety for vehicles entering and existing the premises.
