2014 National MobileMuster Award

On Tuesday, 17 June 2014 at the National General Assembly of Local Government in Canberra, the City of Ryde was presented with an Achievement Award in recognition of our contribution towards creating a better environment.

The Award was in relation to the MobileMuster's National Local Government Awards 2014 in the category of Working with Schools Award and was won for 'the most tonnes of mobile phones recycled in working with our local schools'. The City of Ryde was also the fourth highest in total mobile phones recycled across Australia.

2014 Australasian Reporting Award

On Thursday, 19 June 2014, the City of Ryde was presented with the Gold Award at the 2014 Australasian Reporting Awards. This is the fourth year in a row that the City of Ryde has achieved a Gold Award standard.

The Awards are run by Australasian Reporting Awards Limited, an independent not-for-profit organisation supported by volunteer professionals from the business community and professional bodies concerned about the quality of financial and business reporting. The Awards provide an opportunity for organisations to benchmark their reports against the ARA criteria and their peers in the same industry. The Awards are open to all organisations that produce an Annual Report.

The City of Ryde first entered its Annual Report in the Awards in 2008 and received a Bronze Award. Another Bronze Award was received in 2009 and a Silver Award in 2010. In 2011, the City of Ryde achieved its first Gold Award and that standard has been maintained since.

On behalf of the Council, I would like to congratulate the staff on receiving these Awards and acknowledge their efforts and hard work.
