

MM22/16 REQUEST TO WAIVE WASTE REMOVAL FEE - SALVATION ARMY CHRISTMAS EVENT - The Mayor, Councillor Bill Pickering

Each year the Ryde Salvation Army conducts a Community Christmas Cheer program which this year includes a "free Community Christmas Dinner on 21 December 2016.

The purpose of the dinner is to provide a safe and caring space for members of the local community who may otherwise spend Christmas in loneliness and isolation.

The Salvation Army has requested that Council consider waiving the "waste fees" which would normally be charged for such an event.

It is noted that this is one off request as next year the Salvation Army will apply for a Community Grant through Council's grants program to cover the cost of the supply, delivery and collection of the bins.

The total cost for providing 6 x 240litre general waste bins, 6 x recycle bins and delivery and collection is \$204.40.

I recommend that Council waive the charge of \$204.40 for the provision of garbage bins to cater for the Salvation Army Christmas Cheer luncheon.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council waive the charge of \$204.40 for the provision of garbage bins to be used in relation to the Salvation Army Christmas Cheer luncheon.
