

### 8 RYDE WHARF RESERVE PAVILION - Councillor Bernard Purcell

**File Number:** CLM/20/1/1/6 - BP20/946

- (a) That Council undertake a feasibility study of:-
  - (i) the construction of a pavilion-style venue in Ryde Wharf Reserve on Parsonage Street, Meadowbank.
  - (ii) increased parking at Parsonage Street public car park.
- (b) That a report be brought back to Council by July 2021.



### 9 FOGO - FOOD AND GREEN ORGANICS TRIAL - Councillor Bernard Purcell

File Number: CLM/20/1/1/6 - BP20/947

- (a) That Council investigate and report back within three (3) months with the view to commence the process for a trial to be undertaken for the recycling of food organics waste, within the green organics bin system (Food Organics, Green Organics FOGO), that includes multi-unit dwellings (MUDs) and single-unit dwellings (SUDs).
- (b) That the Ryde City led FOGO trial be funded by the waste reserve and/or other sources of funding as identified as grants etc.
- (c) That the results of the above food waste trial be reported back to Council by March 2022.



## 10 FOOTPATH IN ARNOLD STREET, RYDE (EVEN HOUSE NUMBERS) - Councillor Roy Maggio

- (a) That Council investigate installing a footpath in Arnold Street, Ryde (even house numbers) to improve accessibility for many residents.
- (b) That consultation take place with all affected residents.
- (c) That a report be presented to Council outlining the outcomes of the investigation including an appropriate source of funding, with the works to be completed in December 2020.



### 11 TREE INSPECTIONS - Councillor Roy Maggio

- (a) That Council officers organise tree inspections at the following locations, inviting the resident and interested Councillors:-
  - 6 Moncrieff Drive, East Ryde
  - 5 Lyle Street, Ryde
  - 12A Stratford Avenue, Denistone
  - 11 Stanley Street, Putney
- (b) That the tree inspections be conducted within seven (7) days.
- (c) That a report be presented to Council in October with outcomes of the inspections.



### 12 THE WEEKLY TIMES - 100 YEARS OF LOCAL REPORTING - Councillor Roy Maggio

- (c) That the presentation be conducted at the offices of The Weekly Times with catering arranged by the City of Ryde and funded from the Mayoral budget.

### **MOTION:**

- (b) direct the General Manager to prepare a feasibility report, including a financial source, on establishing a 'Ryde Foodbank' at an appropriate location. The General Manager is to prepare the 'Ryde Foodbank' report for the November 2020 Ordinary Council meeting.



# 15 FIND THE ALTERNATE VENUE FOR THE COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS FROM THE CLOSURE OF THE RYDE CIVIC CENTRE - Councillor Dr Peter Kim

- (a) That the City of Ryde organise an alternate venue for existing individuals, groups or organisation that had their meetings and events bookings cancelled that have not found alternate venues.
- (b) That the City of Ryde after identifying those impacted and the quantum pay for any additional costings incurred as the result of these individuals, groups and organisations having to hire a new venue as the result of temperamental closure of the Ryde Civic Centre.
- (c) That the proposed resolution (as identified in Part (b) above be exhibited for a minimum period of 28 days with a further report being brought back to Council to determine the resolution and any other details following the public exhibition period.
- (d) That an appropriate source of funding be identified in the report after exhibition.
