
Macquarie Park daily commuters


Average travel time daily

Seeing the potential expand the benefits of remote work





Realising benefits of team-based remote work

Jason sees that ongoing remote work options will support employee productivity through a range of factors: "time saved from long commutes, better work/life balance, building motivation and trust and improved job satisfaction."
