The Australasian Recycling Label (ARL)




- The ARL is an evidence-based, standardised labelling system for consumer facing packaging for both Australian and New Zealand markets.
- Provides recycling or disposal options that are available at home or nearby.
- We work with local councils, government, packaging industry, waste & recycling sector, consumers.

How the ARL program works



The ARL is evidenced by an online tool called Packaging Recyclability Evaluation Portal that assesses the recyclability of a piece of household packaging in the New Zealand and Australian resource recovery systems.
