2.0	Guest Speaker 1 – Hayley Durham – Keep Australia Beautiful - <u>HDurham@kabnsw.org.au</u> EnviroMentors is an incursion-based program, offering up to five workshops a day for one class at a time. Incursions are curriculum based and we work around your school's timetable. For Primary Schools , there are three module topics on offer: In the Bin Students get creative through games while gaining knowledge of local waste issues. They learn the appropriate bin to place waste items in and consequences of incorrect bin use. The disposal of tricky waste items such as e-waste and bulky items is also explored. Litter Students have the chance to learn interactively as they act out and brainstorm environmental and social impacts of littering. This inspires students from an early age to protect our environment by correctly disposing of rubbish. A litter audit can also be conducted around the school. School Waste Audit Two "In The Bin" workshops for two classes before lunch- They learn the appropriate bin to place waste items in and consequences of incorrect bin use. After lunch, one selected class or student committee will audit selected bins from around the school to get a better idea of what's actually being taken to landfill and where this can be improved. 3.0	OzHarvest's Food Education and Sustainability Training (FEAST) is a year 5 & 6 curriculum aligned education program. Like any good FEAST, it's designed to be fun, engaging and filled with good food! The FEAST program runs for 10 weeks and is aligned to the NSW syllabus STEM, English and PDHPE learning areas and of course sustainability. The program can be adapted and changed to suit your school's context. FEAST gets kids immersed in hands on cooking activities in the classroom (no kitchen required). To run the program, teachers are encouraged to sign up to professional learning provided by OzHarvest. You can choose from face-to-face or online training so you can comfortably educate and engage your
