

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR 2024 SUSTAINABLE WASTE 2 ART PRIZE

The City of Ryde proudly presents the Sustainable Waste 2 Art Prize. Artists, designers and members of the community are invited to enter the competition and exhibition with art and design objects that relate to sustainable living or waste themes.

CATEGORIES AND PRIZES

- SWAP – OPEN CATEGORY**
Winner \$1,800 / Second prize \$600
Open to artists, designers and members of the community who are 18 years and over.
- YEP - YOUTH ENVIRONMENT PRIZE YOUTH CATEGORY**
Winner \$750 / Second Prize \$250
Open to young people aged 14 to 17 years as at 15 September 2024.
- JUNIOR YEP – YOUNGER CATEGORY**
Winner \$300 / Second Prize \$100
Open to young people aged 10 to 13 years as at 15 September 2024.
- SCHOOLS PARTICIPATION AWARD – \$200**
Awarded to the school with the highest number of entries.
- FUNCTIONAL AWARD**
Winner \$500 / Second Prize \$250
Judged from across all disciplines in SWAP Open Category, YEP and Junior YEP categories. Awarded to the design object which best uses reclaimed material to form a functional piece.
- PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD – \$250**
Open to all applicants who are selected for the exhibitions in any category. Audiences will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite artwork or design object in the exhibition.

ARTWORKS CONSIDERED FOR THE EXHIBITION CAN BE THE FOLLOWING

- A sculpture, assemblage, collage or textile artwork created from used or recycled materials.
- An object that you can use or wear created from used or recycled materials.

ARTWORK CRITERIA

- All two and three dimensional works to be constructed from used or recycled materials.
- Original products can only be used for assembling the work, for binding, bonding and adhering painting.
- The art or design object must be no more than 150cm in height, width or depth (including frame).
- Three dimensional works can be free standing or wall mounted but if wall mounted not exceed 20kg in weight.
- Selection into the exhibition will be based on innovative use of waste materials or the upcycling of waste materials into the art or design object (creating a better quality object or one of higher environmental value).

ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must either live, work, study or play in the City of Ryde. City of Ryde staff, Councillors and those employed or volunteering on the SWAP 2024 project are eligible to apply and be selected for exhibition but are not eligible to win any of the Prizes, with the exception of the People's Choice Award.

ENTRY CRITERIA

It is anticipated that around 80 art and design objects will be selected for the exhibition. All entries must be original work of the exhibitor and created within two years prior to Thursday 5 September 2024. Art and design objects previously exhibited in other prizes and exhibitions are still eligible. For cultural sensitivity reasons, artworks that contain certain unauthorised use of indigenous symbols, motifs or styles are not eligible. Works that are considered offensive will not be selected.

Decisions in regards to works selected for exhibition and final judging by the curatorial panel will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Plinths for smaller sculptural works will be supplied by the gallery.

EXHIBITION

A selection of art and design objects will be chosen for exhibition at See Street Gallery, Meadowbank TAFE. The exhibition will officially open on Thursday 5 September 2024, 6.00 – 8.00pm and will continue until Thursday 19 September 2024. All works selected for the exhibition will remain on display until 4.00pm on the last day of the exhibition. The gallery hours are Tuesday to Saturday, 11.00am – 4.00pm.

SELECTING AND JUDGING

Artwork and design objects for the exhibition will be selected by the judging panel. The City of Ryde reserves the right to change the judges without notification to the entrants. Artists and designers selected for the exhibition will be notified by Friday 2 August 2024. The winners of the major prize categories will be chosen by the same judging panel. The winners of the major prize categories will be announced at the official opening on Thursday 5 September 2024, 6.00pm – 8.00pm at See Street Gallery.

CURATORIAL PANEL

A panel of three expert judges will select the SWAP category winners. The final judging panel will be advertised on the City of Ryde website prior to the opening event on Thursday 5 September 2024.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

The winner of the people's choice award will be determined by the artwork with the highest number of votes cast by the public. The winner of this award will be published on Council's website after the conclusion of the exhibition on Wednesday 25 September 2024.

APPLICATIONS

Applications can be made via the online application form on the City of Ryde website at myryde.info/SWAP.

If entrants wish to submit a hard copy entry, an application form can be downloaded from the City of Ryde website at myryde.info/SWAP.

There is a limit of two entries per person. A separate application form will need to be completed for each entry. Each entry can only be entered into one category.

There is no entry fee to apply for the prize and exhibition.

Each artwork submitted requires two good quality photographs or high resolution JPEG images (minimum 300dpi).

DELIVERY OF ARTWORKS

Selected works are to be delivered to See Street Gallery, Meadowbank TAFE on Thursday 8 August 2024 or Friday 9 August 2024 between 10.00am - 6.00pm, or Saturday 10 August 2024 between 10.00am - 4.00pm.

Two-dimensional work must be ready for hanging with D-rings secured to the back, wire is not accepted. Three-dimensional works that are to hang must have a suitable hook or feature to hang the work from. Plinths will be provided for small artworks, but designers must supply their own mannequins. Works that contain multiple parts must be accompanied by instructions for display.

The position and placement of artworks and design objects within the gallery is at the discretion of the curator.

TRANSPORTATION

Artists and designers are responsible for the transportation of their works to and from the gallery.

SECURITY, LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

Artists and designers exhibit at their own risk. Insurance for the submitted works is the artist's responsibility. The City of Ryde and See Street Gallery, The Northern Sydney Institute – part of TAFE NSW will exercise reasonable care with all works selected for exhibition, but will not be responsible for loss or damage to the work while in their custody, during transit or on exhibition.

SALE OF ARTWORKS

Any sales will be made directly between the artist and the buyer. Sold artworks cannot be removed from the exhibition until after it closes on Thursday 19 September 2024. City of Ryde and Meadowbank TAFE do not take any responsibility for facilitating the sale of SWAP artworks.

DE-INSTALLATION

Artworks and design objects selected for the exhibition must be picked up in person with photo ID or receipt of entry on Friday 20 September 2024 between 10.00am - 6.00pm or Saturday 21 September 2024 between 10.00am - 4.00pm.

Collection of works by other parties requires arrangement with the curator prior to Friday 20 September 2024.

Works that are not collected by Saturday 21 September 2024 may be disposed of.

COPYRIGHT AND PHOTOGRAPHS

Artists and designers own the copyright of their work and licence the City of Ryde to use the submitted images and take photographs of the exhibition that can be used for the exhibition catalogue, publicity, press releases and other promotion in print or on the City of Ryde website for the 2024 and future Sustainable Waste 2 Art Prizes.

INTERPRETATION OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of these terms and conditions, the decision of the City of Ryde shall be binding on all parties.

SIGNING OF DECLARATION
