

ANZAC DAY 25 April

RED POPPIES OF RYDE PATTERN

- Use 8 ply yarn; 4 mm needles
- Cast on 60 stitches
- Rows 1-10: Knit
- Row 11: Knit 2 together across the row (30 stitches)
- Row 12: slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slip stitch over (10 stitches)
- Cut the yarn but leave a long tail (12 inches/30 cm).
- Thread the end of the yarn through a large-eyed sewing needle and then use the sewing needle to thread the yarn through the remaining stitches as you take them off the knitting needle. Pull the yarn tight.
- Sew up the poppy.
- Thread the yarn back to the centre of the poppy. This can be used for attaching the brooch clasp.
- Use black cotton or black yarn to sew on the button.
