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1. Introduction


Understanding population growth and change in your communities enable better planning, resource allocation and appropriate focus of services for the population. The 2021 Census provides insight into where the population has increased or decreased since 2016. In addition, age structure analysis illustrates how the population has changed and where different approaches to service planning, infrastructure provision and resource allocation are needed due to demographic change.

2. Population and age structure summary

- In 2021, the City of Ryde's population was 129,123, an increase of 7,853 from 2016, when the population was 121,270.
- Parts of the City where the population increased most between 2016 and 2021 were Ryde (South), North Ryde Chatswood West and Macquarie Park. Conversely, West Ryde and Ryde (Santa Rosa) experienced a slight population decline.
- The median age of City of Ryde residents in 2021 was 37 years, an increase of one year since 2016, when the median age was 36 years.
- 30–39-year-olds are the largest age group, with 19% (1 in 5 residents) aged 30-39. This group also experienced the most significant increase between 2016 and 2021 (+2.1%).
- In 2021, 16.2% of the population was aged under 15 years, similar to 2016. In 2021, 15% of the City of Ryde population was aged over 65 years, up from 14% in 2016.
- Although the total number increased by 140 between 2016 and 2021, the proportion of City of Ryde residents aged 85 years and over decreased from 2.6% in 2016 to 2.4% in 2021.

3. Population change 2016-2021

- The City of Ryde's population grew from 121,270 in 2016 to 129,123 in 2021, an average annual increase of 1.3%, which was the same as Greater Sydney's growth rate.
- Parts of the City experiencing the highest levels of growth were Ryde (South), North Ryde Chatswood West and Macquarie Park.





4. Age structure 2016-2021

- The median age of City of Ryde residents in 2021 was 37 years, an increase of one year since 2016, when the median age was 36 years.
- The five-year age group which experienced the most growth between 2016 and 2021 was 35-39-year-olds (+1.3%), whereas 20-24-year-olds recorded the largest decline (-1.6%).
- Residents aged under 15 made up 16.2% of the population in 2021 (-0.1% since 2016).
- Residents aged 15-64 years (labour force age group) made up 68.7% of the population in 2021 (-0.7% since 2016).
- Residents aged 65 years or over made up 15.1% of the population in 2021 (+0.8% since 2016).
- Residents aged 85 years or over made up 2.4% of the population in 2021 (-0.2%) since 2016.



4.1 Age structure by small area

- Denistone East had the highest proportion of residents under the age of 15 (12.6%), whereas Macquarie Park had the lowest (7.5%).
- On the other hand, Macquarie Park had the highest proportion of residents aged 15-64 years (80.1%), whereas Denistone East had the lowest (61.4%).
- Ryde (Santa Rosa) had the highest proportion of residents aged over 65 years (19.4%), whereas Macquarie Park, due to a high number of university students, had the lowest (8.8%).
- Marsfield had the highest proportion of residents aged 85 years and over (3.9%), whereas Meadowbank Melrose Park had the lowest (0.7%).
