EVERYONE'S WELCOME AT THE NORTH RYDE PARK REOPENING

A \$750,000 makeover of North Ryde Park, that include upgraded sporting fields, new children's play equipment and public amenities, will be officially opened on Saturday 13 March, with a free family sausage sizzle and children's activities.

"These much improved sporting fixtures and the new family-friendly facilities are already attracting increased numbers of users to North Ryde Park," says the Mayor, Clr Michael Butterworth.

"The new pathways, fencing, canteen and amenities block, including a disabled toilet, make the park more accessible and safer for everyone."

Completed works contained in the North Ryde Park Masterplan, include:

- upgrading of the playing field, including regrading, irrigation and drainage works and returfing
- replacement of the synthetic cricket wicket
- replacement of the fence around the oval
- upgrading of the toilet facilities in the amenities building, including construction of disabled toilets, provision of new fittings and fixtures on the existing toilets and connection to tank water for flushing
- upgrading of the canteen, sports change rooms and storage rooms
- rendering and painting of the outside of the amenities building and provision of new paving and seating out the front
- an upgrade of the playground with new play equipment, a softfall surface, a shade structure and seating
- new picnic and barbecue facilities
- construction of new pathways linking the major elements of the park.
