Item 3 Companion Animals Management Plan – following public exhibition of an updated Management Plan in October 2010, the meeting resolved to adopt the plan. The meeting expressed thanks to the Companion Animal Advisory Committee and suggested highlighting responsible pet ownership guidelines to the community through various communication vehicles. The plan will be reviewed in approximately four years.

Item 4 Procedures for Exercising RTA
Delegation for Traffic Controls – the
meeting resolved not to adopt the
recommendation and retain the previous
delegation that existed prior to October 2010.

Item 5 Saturday Morning Interviews – the meeting resolved to cancel the practise of designated interviews, noting that changes in the way people communicate, as well as time constraints meant that residents now made direct contact with Councillors via mobile or email which often resulted in face to face meetings. The meeting noted that Councillor contact details were easily available through the Ryde City View and on the Council website.

Item 6 Economic Development Advisory
Committee Minutes – the meeting viewed
details of a High Temperature Industrial
Furnace operated by CSIRO, the only facility
of its kind in the southern hemisphere, and
noted the positive economic impact it had on
the City of Ryde. The meeting resolved that
the Mayor and the Chair of the EDAC write to

the Minister for Innovation, Industry, Science & Research seeking the retention of the furnace in the City of Ryde.

Item 7 Requests for Fee Waivers – the meeting endorsed the recommendation that Council decline the request from Ryde Hunters Hill Cricket for the waiver of hire fees of Ryde Park to conduct Harmony Howzat on Sunday 13 March. Council will donate the equivalent of hire fee and bond payment for a Charity Cricket March on 27 March.
