Matter of Urgency

Meeting resolved that Council initiate action to improve pedestrian safety at West Ryde town centre associated with construction works. Works to include temporary lighting in New Betts Street.

Committee meeting held on 21 June 2011 were endorsed.

- 1) With regard to Item 6 (Shaftesbury Road & Glen Street Eastwood/proposed roundabout) - any concept design for this site will take into account several factors including a road safety audit.
