Artist Luke Kim Returns to Brush Farm House

Luke Kim is a renowned artist in the Korean community, yet his art is also distinctly Australian. He finds inspiration from the Australian bush and pastoral land, as well as Australia's unique flora and fauna. Using scenes from the four seasons and the cycle of life, Luke Kim's paintings evoke emotions like sorrow or happiness. His signature shades of green, blue, purple and gold are instantly recognisable.

"It's the mysterious world that is right in front of our eyes that appeals to me," Luke says. "I try to give a unique perspective on everyday scenes.

"This will be my 14th exhibition since moving to Australia, and after several successful exhibitions at Brush Farm House, I can think of no better venue for my new one, *Themes from a Natural World*.
